





CAMPSITE DESCRIPTION

CAPACITY

288 total beds (*cabins are heated but not air-conditioned*)

CABINS 1, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8	sixteen beds each (8 upper and 8 lower bunks) with bathrooms that have two lavatories, two commodes, and two showers	96
CABIN 2	four beds (2 upper and 2 lower bunks) and a bathroom with shower	4
CABIN 5A	two beds (1 upper and 1 lower bunk) and a bathroom with shower	2
CABIN 6	sixteen beds (8 upper and 8 lower bunks) with two bathrooms that each have two lavatories, one commode, and one shower. NOTE: One bathroom is ADA accessible	16
CABINS A-H	fourteen beds each (7 upper and 7 lower bunks) and bathrooms with two lavatories, one commode, and one shower. NOTE: Cabins B and C are ADA accessible	112
CABINS I AND J	twenty beds each (10 upper and 10 lower bunks) and bathrooms with two lavatories, two commodes, and two showers	40
CABINS K AND L	two bunk beds in each cabin. The two cabins share a bathroom/shower	8
CABINS M AND N	two bunk beds in each cabin. The two cabins share a bathroom/shower	8
HEADQUARTERS	separate building has a small office, infirmary, and sleeping quarters (one bunk bed and full bath with shower) for a nurse or healthcare provider. These rooms are air-conditioned	2

KITCHEN

The kitchen has a commercial LP gas range (ten burners, two convection ovens), a five-foot grill, a double LP gas convection oven, a holding oven, a large pantry, a reach-in refrigerator, a walk-in refrigerator, a walk-in freezer, an ice machine, a microwave oven, and a commercial mixer. A dish washing machine with detergent and sanitizer is provided. You need to bring dish soap for a three-well sink for scrubbing pots and pans.

The kitchen is supplied with plates, cups, bowls, tumblers, flatware, and serving pieces. A cafeteria-style steam table/serving counter accommodates cafeteria style serving. Food preparation utensils and containers are well-stocked including large spoons, forks, ladles, spatulas, tongs, sharp knives, large bowls, sheet pans (18" x 22"), roasting pans, a coffee maker, pitchers, muffin pans, funnels, strainer/colander, whisk, etc.

- Please do not use disposable products such as paper plates, plastic cups, tableware, etc.
- Plan to bring all consumable goods such as paper towels, toilet paper, 10-cup basket-style coffee filters, trash bags, dish towels, soap, cleaning supplies, etc.
- Please plan to haul your garbage to a dumpster located on the property. A trailer is provided at the campsite for hauling garbage. A 2" ball hitch is required.
- BBQ barrels are available, but you must bring your own charcoal, firewood, and starter.

DINING

Inside dining is available with folding tables in the Ranch House. This enclosed dining space doubles as a meeting area. The inside dining area is heated but not air-conditioned. The covered, open-air patio can also be used for dining or activities.

WATERFRONT

At the primary waterfront area, the water is quiet but deep and only safe for competent swimmers. Pebble Beach, a short distance upstream, gradually slopes to water about four feet deep.

- A certified lifeguard must supervise all waterfront activity.
- While fishing, please observe our "catch & release" policy.
- Canoes are available. Personal flotation devices are provided and must be worn in the canoes.

PAVILIONS

- The Frog Sullivan Pavilion seats 300 for covered open-air meetings, worship, skits, and presentations. The pavilion has electric outlets, but no A/V equipment is available.
- An Activities Pavilion is available with bleacher seating for 150

RECREATION

- Two tennis courts, a basketball court, two sand volleyball courts, a softball diamond, a playing field, and a frisbee golf course are available. You must provide your own sports equipment.
- Hiking trails are nearby.
- A campfire ring is located near the river adjacent to the Ranch House—please bring your own firewood.
